INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC RULES AND REGULATIONS

To be a member of a Colonial Forge High School team is a privilege and not a right. This applies to the sports program as well as other extracurricular activities. A student must abide by the athletic department rules regarding practices and training and the specific requirements of the coach of the sport in which he/she is participating. These rules are set to insure an athlete's safe and efficient participation in the sport.

SCHOOL RULES

1. All athletes must be in attendance before the end of first block in order to practice or play that day.
2. Athletes must abide by all school rules and regulations.
3. Interscholastic uniforms or parts of uniforms may be worn for participation in the sport for which it is issued.
4. Athletes are financially responsible for uniforms and equipment issued to them beyond normal wear and tear.
5. Any student who has not completed his/per payment obligations at the close of the season may not be allowed to compete in any further competition until the obligation is complete.
6. All students are responsible for adhering to the Stafford County Extra/Co-Curricular Policy (Policy #3502) and team rules.
7. Family vacations that interfere with organized practice and/or games should be discussed with the coach. Athletes and parents must realize missed practice may affect the playing time of that athlete and whether they letter or receive awards.
8. When an athlete or manager resigns or is dismissed from a team after the first game, math or meet, he/she will be ineligible to participate in any athletic or intramural program until the season is over for the team from which he/she resigned, or they have been granted permission by the coach of the team from which they resigned.

VHSL ELIGIBILITY RULES

1. You must be taking five (5) units of work towards graduation.
2. You must pass at least five (5) unit credits towards graduation at the end of the regular marking period. (Semester)
3. You may not turn nineteen (19) years of age on or before August 1.
4. If you have changed schools with a change of legal residence, you may be ineligible for VHSL activities.
5. If you have played in the same sport for more than four (4) seasons in grades, 9, 10, 11, and 12 you are ineligible.
6. Must have had a sport physical dated after May 1 to try-out, practice or play.
